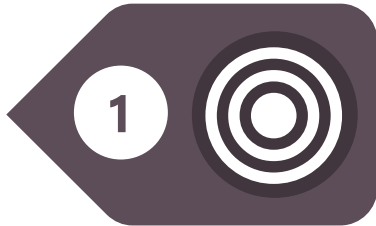

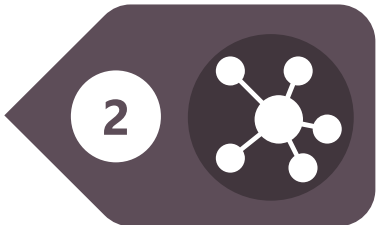

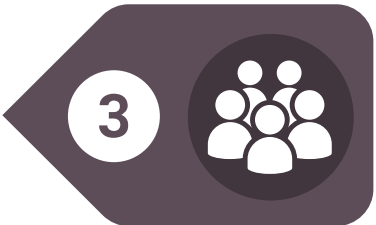
Thurs 6th Sept: Goal Setting and building a case for support

A session to help you build partnerships and design better services together - finding potential partners and volunteers, co design, co-production and co-delivery of services



Thurs 27th Sept: Because your'e worth it! - Proving your value

A session to help you demonstrate the difference you make - outputs, outcomes, and impact and capturing stories for evaluation
